Federal Work-Study provides part-time jobs for undergraduate and graduate students with financial need, allowing them to earn money to help pay education expenses. The program encourages work related to the student's course of study.

## Steps to Qualify and Find a Job

1

When you complete your FAFSA, ask to be considered for Federal Work-Study funding.

2

Receive your Financial Aid Award Letter with acceptance status.

3

Find a work-study position on the Hire System at *HireOSUGrads.com*.

4

Apply to work-study positions, interview, and get hired!

## WHAT IS WORK-STUDY?

Despite the way it sounds, "Work-Study" does not refer to jobs that pay you to study.

Work-study is a form of financial aid in which the Federal Government pays a portion of your paycheck. Nearly all on-campus, and some local non-profit jobs, can be filled by work-study recipients.
